### **VIRGINIA HORSE CENTER GENERAL RULES**

1. Upon arrival at the Virginia Horse Center, all trailers must check in at the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
2. No smoking in Coliseum or Barns. This is the law.
3. **VEHICLES:** Drive Carefully. Obey All Traffic Signs. Speed limits are strictly enforced. ***Every vehicle operator must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.*** The use of vehicles in the camping areas is restricted to regular roadways for entering and exiting only. Vehicles are permitted only if operated in a safe manner (this is a Virginia state law) but *may not* be used in the Coliseum or in the interior of any of the barns. Four wheelers and ATVs are not permitted on the VHC grounds. Non-powered scooters, bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, heelers (skates in shoes) are not permitted in the Coliseum or the interior of any of the barns. **The VHC reserves the right to prohibit the operation of any vehicle.**
4. **Dogs/Pets:** All dogs/pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by state of residency. No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs/pets that are not crated must be on a hand-held or tied leash. *Loose dogs/pets will incur a \$100 fine.* You must clean up after your dog/pet.  
**Coliseum:** Dogs are allowed in the Coliseum as long as they are on a leash. No dogs/pets in the Mezzanine (2nd floor of the Coliseum) under any circumstances with the exception of Service Dogs. We ask that your Service Dog have his or her vest on. **Grounds/Parking Areas/Barns/East Complex:** All dogs/pets must be on a hand-held or tied leash.
5. No trash or sharps in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in red boxes in barns. *Shows will be charged \$1,000 for sharps in the manure pits.*
6. **ALCOHOL:** At events serving alcohol, all ABC laws must be followed. If asked to provide Identification for purposes of age validation, you must comply. Those individuals who do not comply will not be served alcohol. Disorderly patrons will be removed from the premises.
7. **Theft/Vandalism:** Anyone involved in destroying property or found stealing property will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
8. All stalls must have at least one bale of shavings or straw. Sawdust is prohibited. Shavings may be purchased at the Welcome Center (Stable Office).
9. No lunging in Posted rings. Wiley, Northern, and B Ring **NEVER**.
10. No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
11. Horses are absolutely **not** allowed to be ponied behind any moving vehicles.
12. No vehicles allowed in the barns.
13. Campers must register at Stable Office/Welcome Center.
14. Check-In time and Check-Out time subject to show date.
15. No **gray water** is to be dumped on the ground. Sewage arrangements are made through the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
16. Campfires are not permitted.
17. Campers must keep their sites clean and dispose of refuse in the receptacles provided. All campers will be responsible for leaving the campsite as they found it. Any damage or repairs resulting from negligence shall be the responsibility of the camper.
18. All central service buildings and other facilities in the campground are for campers' and exhibitors' use only.
19. Firearms and fireworks are not permitted.
20. No tent, camper, RV or camping equipment shall be left unattended longer than 24 hours without written permission from campground management.
21. Any loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the Virginia Horse Center Security. Lost and Found is located in the Security Office.
22. Virginia Horse Center management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who is in violation of these rules and regulations.
23. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any respect from camper's occupancy and use of premises, and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.
24. There will be a fine for anything hooked to or suspended from electrical conduit in the barns. This is extremely dangerous and electrocution could occur.
25. There will be a \$500 fine to any exhibitor who empties trash/manure from muck buckets or trash cans in ANY stalls assigned to the exhibitor, or unused stalls.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### ENTRIES

Entries must be submitted on the official entry form for this show. All HORSES SHOULD BE PRE-REGISTERED WITH ENTRIES BEING POST-MARKED NO LATER THAN September 11, 2021. No phone entries will be accepted. Entry blanks are available by contacting the show secretary or visiting [www.vahorsecenter.org](http://www.vahorsecenter.org). STALL FEES ARE THE ONLY FEES THAT ABSOLUTELY MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM. All entries, changes and scratches must be made ONLY with the show secretary in the Horse Show Office and must be made ONE HOUR before the beginning of each session.

### CAMPING SPACES

The Virginia Horse Center has 78 camping spots with 30/50 amp electric & water hookups. Camping is \$46.12 per night (tax included) payable to the Virginia Horse Center. Reservations can be made online at [www.vahorsecenter.org](http://www.vahorsecenter.org) or at the Welcome Center/Stable Office. Selection of reserved sites is upon arrival. Camping without reservations will be permitted only if there are vacancies. Questions can be directed to [stableoffice@horsecenter.org](mailto:stableoffice@horsecenter.org) or 540-464-2966.

### CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

To be eligible to compete in a championship class, horses must be entered, shown, and judged in a qualifying class in its division or section.

### PAYMENTS

You can use Cash or Check to pay your entries. STALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL OR AN OPEN CHECK RECEIVED BEFORE STALLS ARE ASSIGNED. The Rockbridge Horse Show will enforce an OPEN CHECK POLICY. An open check or cash must be left with the office in the exhibitor's folder before any back number will be released. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor or agent to settle his account within 30 minutes after the end of the show. Failure to do so will give the Horse Show Secretary authority to fill in the correct amount owed to the Horse Show. All checks returned for non-payment will be charged a \$50 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or money order.

### CLASSES

All classes are non-rated with USEF. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGE IS FINAL.

### COGGINS/HEALTH CERTIFICATES

State law mandates that each exhibitor must possess a negative Coggins Test executed within the past twelve (12) months for each horse brought on grounds. Please ensure that the name of the horse that appears on the Coggins Papers matches the horse's name on all entry blanks. A copy of the Coggins Test must be submitted with entries and will remain as a permanent part of the show file. Health Certificates should be available for all horses from out of state according to federal law.

### EXHIBITORS' RESPONSIBILITIES

Exhibitors are required to give the necessary personal attention to and maintain control of their animals and equipment at all times. When animals are moved about, they shall be constantly attended. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss or damage done to, occasioned by, or arising from any animal or vehicle owned or exhibited by the exhibitor and shall indemnify the show and hold it harmless from any loss, cost or expense caused. The exhibitor assumes all risk of loss, injury, or damage of every kind and nature, however caused to the property belonging to him and any of his employees. Exhibitors are urged to keep attendants at their exhibit at all times and to carry insurance for their protection against any losses that might be incurred and to protect themselves from risks assumed under this clause.

### GOLF CARTS

VHC has golf carts available for rent. Carts cost \$105.30 per day (tax included), payable to the Virginia Horse Center. Reservations for the carts will be handled directly with the Stable Office at the Virginia Horse Center by emailing [stableoffice@horsecenter.org](mailto:stableoffice@horsecenter.org) or by phone 540-464-2966.

### GROUND FEES

There will be a \$20 grounds fee per horse per day charged for showing off your trailer. Every horse must either have a stall or pay a grounds fee. ***Please be advised that the sound system /ram the coliseum DOES NOT reach to the parking areas. You will be responsible for monitoring the progress in the show ring & arrive in the warm-up area in ample time for your class.***

### IN-GATE CLOSING

There will be a two (2) minute gate call commencing after the first horse enters the ring unless a hold has been announced. All requests for holds shall be submitted only to the Show Secretary. Requests for a hold shall be submitted at least 5 classes in advance. Judging will not start until the gate is officially closed.

### MEDICAL WASTE

The Virginia Horse Center provides Red BioHazard Containers located at the wash racks in each barn for the disposal of all used needles, syringes and other supplies. Medical waste must not be discarded in stalls, manure pits, garbage cans or on the grounds. Violators will be prosecuted.

### OFFICE FEES

Each horse will be assessed a one-time office fee of \$5.00 payable on the entry blank.

### OFFICE LOCATION

The Horse Show Office will be located upstairs in the coliseum - on the concourse between the in-gate and out-gate .

### PARKING

All horse trailers & vans will be permitted to park in the parking lot located between Barn 1 (Famesgate) & Barn 2 (Sundowner) and Maury River Road. In the event that these parking lots are being renovated, parking will be designated by VHC personnel. Another show will be using the East Complex, so please respect their space.

### PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be paid by check within thirty (30) days after the show closes. All accounts must be paid in full before checks can be issued.

### REFUNDS

Refunds requested in writing before Sept . 15, 2021 will be honored, less a \$20.00 administration fee. No refunds after this date unless the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of illness or lameness on an official letterhead. Another horse may be substituted .

### SCHOOLING

Schooling will not be allowed between barns. Anderson Coliseum will be open until midnight each night & at other times when the show is not in session. The ring must be cleared ½ hour prior to each session in order for show preparation.

### RESPONSIBILITIES: HORSE SHOW

The Rockbridge Horse Show and its Management will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it will be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor or owner shall hold the Horse Show and its Management harmless for any loss or accident to his or her horse(s) or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. The Horse Show and its Management will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way by exhibitors, spectators, employees or other involved parties. HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO: (1) Vary or add to the names of those officials who have been invited to participate. (2) Add, combine or cancel any class. (3) Refuse any or all entries, return any money paid for stalls or entry fees without explanation or recourse to the Show for liability or compensation . The Show shall be under absolute control of the Management. Only qualified persons shall be allowed in the ring during judging. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials by the owner, rider, trainer, or groom will disqualify horse or rider, and the owner shall forfeit all fees and payments.

### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Smoking inside barns is prohibited . Bicycles may not be ridden in the barns, coliseum or any part of the upper facility. Failure to comply will result in the impounding of the bicycle until the close of the show. No vehicles are allowed in the interior of the barns at anytime . Golf carts, powered scooters and mopeds will be permitted on THE grounds and must be registered with the stable office prior to use on the grounds. These vehicles can only be operated by a person who holds a valid unrestricted motor vehicle driver's license. Motorcycles, four-wheelers, non-powered scooters, skateboards and inline skates are not permitted on the premises. Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks and hot plates are prohibited in stall area, unless approved by the stable office management. All electrical extension cords must be twelve (12) gauge, three (3) wire and prong negative grounds type.

### STALLS

ALL STALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL IN ADVANCE OR WITH OPEN CHECK BEFORE STALLS CAN BE ASSIGNED. The fee for a horse stall or tack stall is \$75.00. Stalls are to be used by one horse only and will be bedded with shavings only. Shavings are available for purchase and must be paid for (or leave an open check) when picked up at the designated stable office. Exhibitors are encouraged to pre-order bedding with the Stable Office. Feed and hay will be available for purchase at the stable office. Phone: 540-464-2966

### IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION

Paddock calls are made as a courtesy & every effort will be made to ensure that exhibitors are kept informed . However , with any mechanical device, unexpected problems may arise. Each exhibitor is responsible for being at the gate when his class is called.
